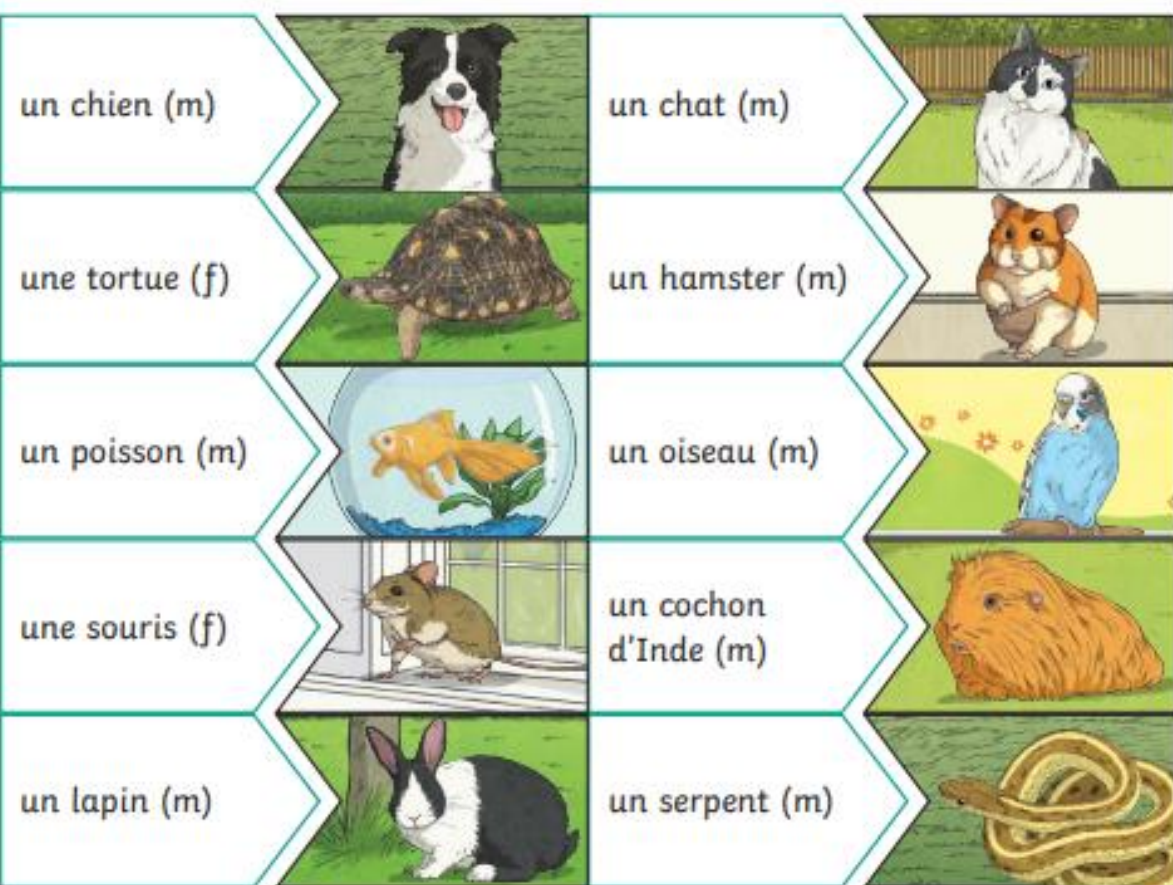

**Key Vocabulary and Grammar - French Alphabet**

The French alphabet has 26 letters, the same as in English. These sound groups should help you with pronouncing the French letters.

<b>/ey/</b> = closed 'e' sound, like the é in 'café'	<b>/ee/</b> = long, closed 'e' sound, as in 'me'
<b>b c d g p t v w</b>	<b>i j x y</b>
<b>/eh/</b> = open 'e' sound, as in 'effort'	<b>/oo/</b> = short 'o' sound, as in 'you'
<b>f l m n r s z</b>	<b>q u</b>
<b>/ah/</b> = open, slightly elongated 'a' sound, halfway between 'cat' and 'cart'	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Letter 'o' is halfway between 'box' and 'though'.</li> <li>• Letter 'e' is halfway between 'up' and 'hurt'.</li> </ul>
