Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may be aware, Year 4 will be exploring 'The Romans' this term. As a way of enhancing this exciting topic, we plan to have a 'Roman Day' on Wednesday 19th September.

To help make this a memorable experience, we have arranged for a visit from a Roman specialist who will carry out range of activities. Throughout the day the children will explore Roman art and taste typical foods eaten in Roman times. They will also be able to use all the experiences of the day in their English and maths work.

In order to help the children get into the spirit of the day, we would like to encourage as many children as possible to come into school wearing a Roman style outfit, e.g. a sheet tied as a toga or a simple tunic with a blanket for a cloak. Regardless of what the children wear, we are sure that the boys and girls will have an enjoyable day.

To cover the cost of the workshops we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £4.50.
